

Grade Evaluation for Courses Offered by the Center for Global Education

The grade evaluation criteria for the Global Liberal Arts Courses of the Center for Global Education, The University of Tokyo are prescribed as follows:

Grade	Out of a possible 100-points	Criteria for Evaluation	Result
A+	90-100	Completed the course with an outstanding grade	Pass (P)
A	80-89	Completed the course with an excellent grade	
B	65-79	Completed the course with a good grade	
C	50-64	Completed the course with a fair grade	
F	0-49	Insufficient and not completed the course	Fail (F)

When assessing the achievement of registered students in a five level scale course, generally the top five to ten percent of registered students for a course will receive the grade of "A+", and the top thirty percent will receive the grade of "A", including students receiving the grade of "A+". However, this policy may not apply to five-level scale courses with a small number of registered students (20 or less).

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
